### What is the CAR (Conference Agenda Report)?

From NA World Services: *“The purpose of the conference is to **define and take action according to the group conscience of Narcotics Anonymous** and fulfill the WSC Mission Statement: to honor the spiritual principles of NA’s Twelve Steps, Traditions, and Concepts for Service; and to use resources efficiently to sustain its functions.”* GSRs will be provided a copy at February’s CJASC. ### How does voting work?

Each group has a voice! Groups submit their votes to their Region (NJRSC), and the Regional Delegates for each region bring the conscious of that region to the World Service Convention in May 2026.

### What is the GSR’s role?

The GSR will be responsible for the following: 1) Review the information in motions and survey with their group; 2) Obtain a group conscious for each motion and survey topic (*most groups do this via group vote, though each group is autonomous*); 3) Submit their group’s conscious (via web) no later than 4/15/2026.

### 2026 CAR Motions

Each member votes on CAR Motions one time, with one group. The GSR submits the group’s conscious via the nanj.org website by 4/15/2026.

### 2026 CAR Survey

Each member only provides their feedback to one group, and GSRs submit their group’s feedback along with the CAR Motion votes. However, the CAR Survey also *allows individuals and service bodies to provide feedback independent of a homegroup.*

- GSRs submit group feedback by 4/15/2026 (same form as motion votes)
- Individuals and service bodies must submit their feedback at the links below no later than 4/1/2026 (note this deadline is **earlier**)
